Food safety experts from government, industry, and academia will gather in Madison, Wisconsin on May 17 and 18 for the annual Food Research Institute Spring Meeting at the University of Wisconsin-Madison. Throughout its history, the Institute has helped the food industry identify and solve food safety issues. Its focus on food microbiology and toxicology involves effective partnerships with industry and government. This year's presentations will also be offered virtually via Zoom.

The hybrid program will include presentations on product development and consumer trends; clean-label antimicrobials; plant-based proteins; practical food safety solutions, microbiome, probiotics, and more. This meeting features scientists from the University of Wisconsin-Madison and other universities as well as industry and government.

Lori Ledenbach of Kraft Heinz will present the William C. Frazier Memorial lecture and will be recognized for her contributions to food microbiology and safety. Tuesday evening's program features a poster session, reception, and opportunities to network with colleagues.
